Dear M. Jasna Žugić

Thank you for your email.

So far, the Serbian organisation "Sub-Media" has not received any funding under the Creative Europe Culture Sub-programme.

In fact, an organisation established on 30 January 2015 is not eligible to submit a grant application. To be eligible, a culture organisation must have been legally established for minimum 2 years, as specified in the relevant guidelines for potential applicants.

Besides that, as you also point out, it would be impossible to thoroughly assess hundreds of applications in only two weeks. Although we have streamlined the selection process as much as possible, it still takes about 5 months in total as it includes many steps and each of them is carried out very carefully and analytically in order to ensure the highest possible quality of the whole process.

We are sending you herewith the link to our database, where you can find information and results of projects supported by the European Commission under the current Creative Europe programme and under the previous Culture 2007-2013 programme.

I need some basic information about an organization from Subotica, Serbia, which claims that is funded by Creative Europe Programme, but is a bit shady with sharing information about their projects.

Organization "Sub-media" from Subotica announced that they got money from two foundations - Creative Europe Programme and European Cultural Centre for four large projects: "Sub-media Academy", "Sub-media info centre", "Sub-media art scene" and "Sub-media collection".

This organization is very young, they formed on 30th January, and the news about them doing projects of building a church, theatre stage, founding an academy etc. was out on 14th of February.

I find it quite impossible that application could be checked in two weeks and that one serious and big organization as yours could finance such young organization with huge projects.

They don't want to share information about these projects with public.

Could you send me a link where I could find list of organizations and projects that are supposed to be done this year, if there is such list? Or could you tell me if you funded organization called Sub-media? Or was there a project application process that finished in the middle of February?

I am a journalist at Youth radio station in Novi Sad (oradio.rs), that is a part of Radio Television of Vojvodina - the public broadcaster in the Serbian province of Vojvodina.
